The Quesnel & District Heritage Association actively promotes the restoration of antique machinery and artifacts that are important to the history and development of the Quesnel and District region. Their goal is to provide education to the public of how our ancestors managed to live day to day using the items on display. They are run by volunteers of all ages who are interested and dedicated to the preservation and display of antique machinery in a viable and exciting interactive facility. Located just south of town on Hwy 97, the park has many trails and walkways to access the various displays. The completion of the trail restoration will improve the access of the facilities for all visitors. This is the third QCF grant awarded to QDHA since 2003.
