## **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**



Wow! We have had a great year for the Quesnel Community Foundation! And great in many ways, but especially in building our endowment and in grants to local community groups.

Our 2015 autumn fundraising campaign went extremely well and I am proud to report that our Funds have now passed the \$2 million mark and are still growing, all thanks to a very generous local base of contributors. The drive started off with an anonymous donor offering to match all donations to the Community Endowment Fund up to \$50,000. In all, the drive brought in over \$150,000 total donations. A number of new family funds were created as well as two new scholarship funds. Well done, Quesnel!

Our 2016 grant cycle was also very successful. We have a great group of dedicated citizens who work behind the scenes in helping to evaluate and choose the best projects which will have a lasting benefit to our area. While all projects are important to the applicable local groups, many projects we were unable to support because we just don't have the funds for everything. The continued growth on the Foundation did mean, though, that we were able to award more this year, including grants and scholarships, than ever before: \$65,350. This money comes as a result of earnings from the Community Endowment Fund and designated Memorial Bursary Funds, with no drawdown on capital, meaning we will be able to grant a similar amount, or more, in 2017.

This "Report to Community" lists the projects we have been able to support, and we look forward to learning of the projects seeking funds in 2017. To all interested local community groups, please note your Letters of Intent are due in to us by 5.00pm on Friday January 13th. See our website for all the details.

You may know that our Directors are permitted to serve up to two consecutive 3-year terms, and this year Dan Canuel and Sheri Coles each completed six years of invaluable service to our Board. These people are great leaders in the community and they will be missed from the Board. I'm happy to report, however, that both have stayed on within our committees.

The vacancies on the Board have been filled by two other hardworking community members.

We welcome Jim Gorsline and Mary Sjostrom to our board. Jim and Mary have a long history serving this community and we are pleased to have them with us. They have both jumped right in and are already making a contribution.

Lastly, we have once again been blessed by the generosity of a donor who is prepared to match up to \$50,000 of donations made to the Foundation by December 10th. Whether by cheque, cash, credit card, or in-kind, please support us in any way you can. Most of our money doesn't come from large corporations (although they are always lending a helping hand); it comes from people such as you and me.

After all, "we give here because we live here." Quesnel is our home and we are proud of it.

#### 2016 Grants

Established in 2001, the Quesnel Community Foundation exists to meet the needs of our community through the growth and management of permanent endowment funds.

Our goal is to use the income generated from those funds to promote the well-being and enhance the quality of life of our community by providing grants to charitable organizations.

In 2016, we provided Grants totalling \$60,600 – our largest annual sum so far, bringing our total Grant awards since 2001 to \$420,497 spread across 157 projects to 76 community groups serving the Arts, Recreation, Education, Environment, and Social need.

This has been achieved with your help, as donors and volunteers, and without ever having to encroach upon the capital. When you donate to the Foundation, it really is the gift that will keep on giving.
