PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



On behalf of the Quesnel Community Foundation Board of Directors, I am pleased to provide our community update for 2019. As per the audited financial statements, our fundraising for 2018 including in-kind and sponsors was \$259,009 and the Endowment Fund as of December 31, 2018 was \$2.8 million dollars. Thank-you Quesnel! This is truly a team effort and I would like to thank our hard-working Board of Directors for their support as volunteers to our Foundation. This year we said goodbye to Tom Weckworth and Deb Burton. Tom served on the Board for four years as our Treasurer and Investment Committee Member. Deb Burton was co-chair of our Gala Committee but left the community due to a job transfer. We will miss both these great folks and thank them for their dedication and support. We welcome Laurie Rice as our new Treasurer.

The Quesnel Community Foundation operates to meet the need of our Community through the growth and management of permanent endowment funds. We administer our funds under the premise that donations received will be used to generate investment income that funds our grants and scholarships. The capital generated by donations is never spent. As our endowment grows, our ability to grant does too. In 2019 we awarded \$80,400 to 12 community groups in the form of grants and over \$12,000 in bursaries and scholarships to local students. In addition, Island Mountain Arts and Friends of the Museum received \$3900 from Agency Funds.

Our fundraising efforts over the years has been assisted by an extremely generous anonymous donor and we so appreciate the support and confidence in our great organization. Once again, this year our donor will provide matching funds to the Foundation for donations received between November 1 to December 15th up to a maximum of \$50,000. Please take up the challenge! 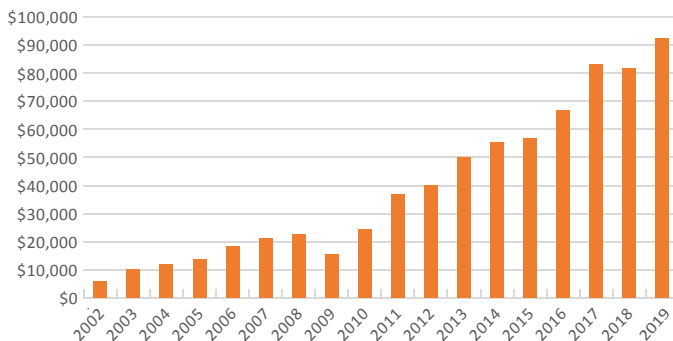

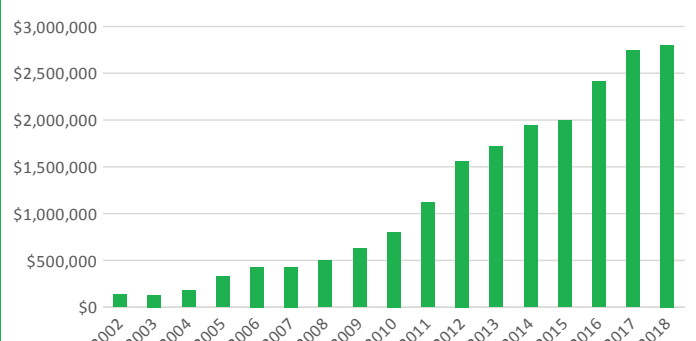

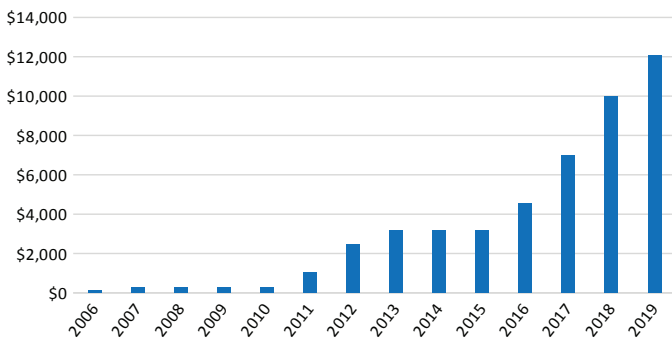
NEWEST DESIGNATED FUND

RBC FOUNDATION FUTURE LAUNCH

The Community Foundations of Canada (CFC) and RBC Foundation teamed up to provide Foundations with grant money for local youth initiatives.

The RBC Future Launch Community Challenge is a national initiative that supports youth leaders as they respond to local priorities and prepare for the future. The Challenge supports bold, youth-led ideas that address urgent community priorities in 150 communities. The grant cycle ran from May 1 to September 30. We would like to thank RBC Foundation and Community Foundations of Canada for making \$15,000 available for local youth in Quesnel and area. A committee consisting of two local youth and three QCF Directors selected the Quesnel Pride Society to receive the funding. The Society plans to host meetings twice per week for peer-run activities and professional education about, and for, the LGBTQ+ community. As part of our agreement with CFC we have committed to a community session called a 'Vital Conversation'. We will be sending out more information on the date, time and objective of this in the New Year.
